## **5. Venue & Dates**

The venue and dates are not yet finalised which we all know is not satisfactory. We indicated in a recent bulletin on the website that the likely dates are for the two weeks from 12 August 2012 and the likely venue Strasbourg. Nothing is guaranteed!

## **6. Amount of Subsidy**

Until the venue is known the amount of the NZB subsidy for Players can't be set **but Players are advised that the subsidy will be performance based.**

The International Committee resolved the subsidy would comprise a reasonable base figure which would increase for each team which achieved halfway or better in their respective sections at the Mind Sports Games.

Any team finishing in the top four would receive a further payment. Performance will be a factor which the International Committee will bear in mind in future years in deciding what teams we send to participate in International events.

## **7. Selection Process**

The selectors will select teams for the Centre Island and North Island Teams as well. The top performing pair in each section and who have played in ALL three events earns automatic selection whereas the remaining two pairs in each team will be chosen by the Selectors. For the two pairs to be selected the datum performance will be a guide only to the Selectors who will have unfettered discretion in their selection.
